GUIDE8:00 **11** JFK ASSASSINATION—Discussion

SPECIAL **COLOR** Attorneys Louis Nizer and Mark Lane meet head-to-head in a heated and often bitter debate over the Warren Commission's report on the assassination of President Kennedy.

The program, which offers defenders of the Warren Commission and its findings a chance to rebut their critics, is moderated by David Schoenbrun.

Assisting in Nizer's rebuttal are Albert E. Jenner Jr., assistant counsel to the Commission, and Commission staffer Alfreda Scobey. Lane, representing the opposition, has persistently attacked the Commission in lectures, on TV and in his book "Rush to Judgment."

Important questions in the hotly contested debate include the conspiracy theory; the condition and path of the fatal bullet; and the Mannlicher-Carcano rifle—whether it was actually owned by Oswald, used to kill the President, or even brought into the book depository building by Oswald.
